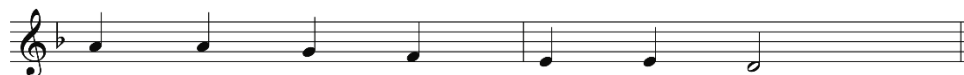

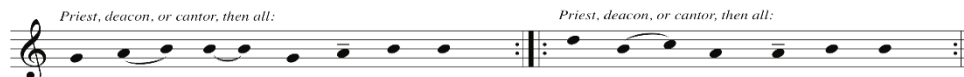

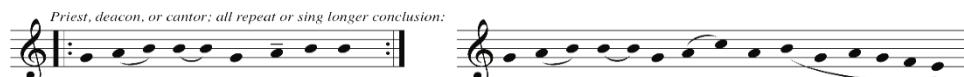
Penitential Rite






