who call on him in truth. *℟.*

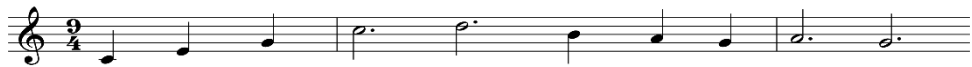

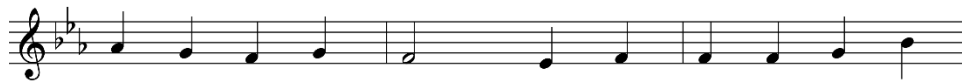
