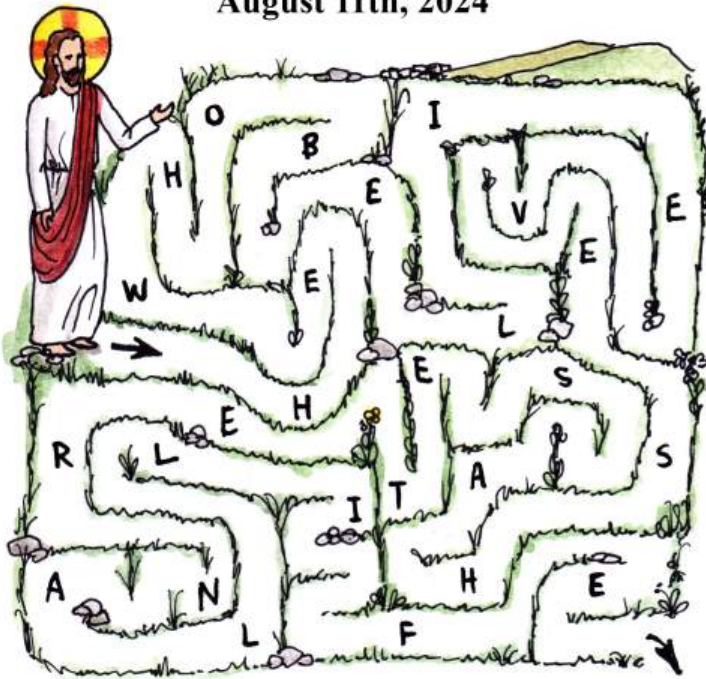

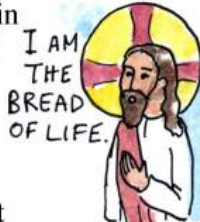
## Believing in Jesus

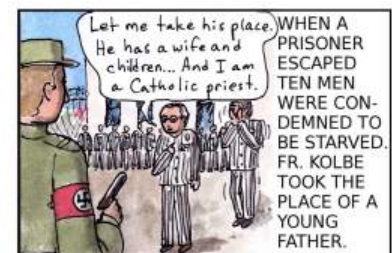
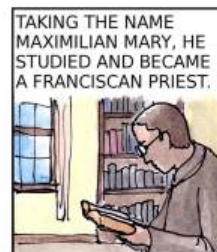
