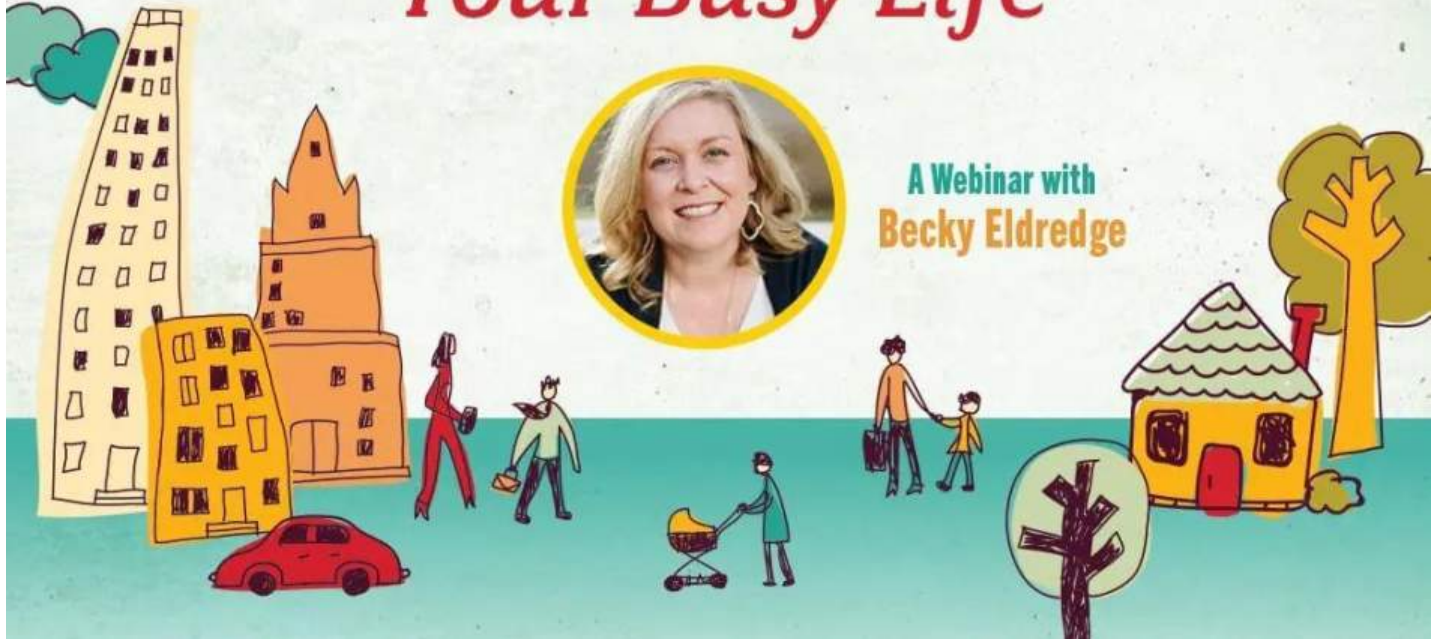

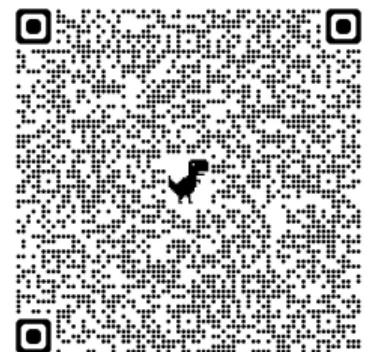

Celebrate World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly

September 8, 2024



In 2021, Pope Francis established the celebration of the World Day for Grandparents and Elderly on the fourth Sunday of July, near the liturgical memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus (July 26).

The U.S. bishops have approved the transfer of the celebration of World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in the United States to the first weekend after Labor Day in September (this year **Sept. 8**) to coincide with National Grandparents (and the Elderly) Day in the United States as many local communities, schools, and parishes have celebrated for some time.

To celebrate this special day, invite your grandparents or older friends and neighbors to Mass, where they will receive a special blessing. Invite them to breakfast or lunch after Mass. Interview your grandparents and learn about their life experiences and what life was like before the cell phone! Look at old family photos and share stories. Take photos with your grandparents.

Protecting God's Children Course: August 26, 2024 6:30–9:30 p.m.

Maximizing a church's role as a child-safe environment begins with making adults more aware of the ways children and adults interact with each other. The Protecting God's Children program educates and trains adults (clergy, religious, teachers, staff, volunteers, and parents) about the dangers of abuse, the warning signs of abuse, the ways to prevent abuse, the methods of properly reporting suspicions of abuse, and responding to allegations of abuse.

On August 26th from 6:30–9:30 p.m. in Larkin Hall, St. Cassian will offer the Protecting God's Children program for adults. This three-hour live awareness session instructs adults of the Church that, to protect children, you must have continuous awareness and vigilance. This awareness session makes trainees understand the signs of child sexual abuse, the methods and means by which offenders commit abuse, and five empowerment steps one can use to prevent child sexual abuse.

HE LEARNED FROM THE GREAT BISHOP, SAINT AMBROSE.

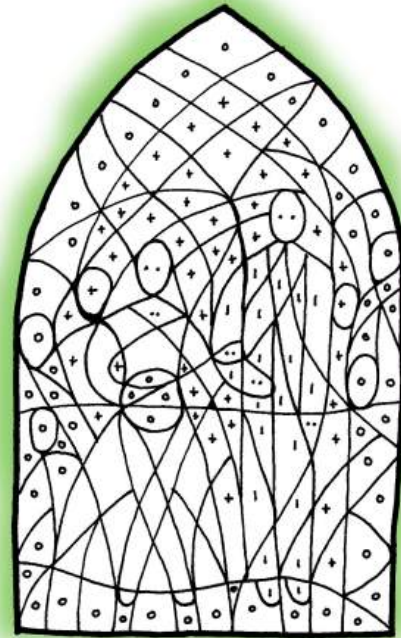
