# LADY JACQUELINE OF THE HOUSE OF SETTESOLI

With the approaching Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi—October 4th—many of us are unaware of the unique and remarkable friendship that existed between *Il Poverello*, “the Little Poor Man,” and the noblewoman Dona Jacoba of the House of Settesoli.

Saint Francis’s biographers recount that, after his conversion and new way of evangelical life, Francesco Bernardone would publicly preach about the love of God on the piazzas and street corners of his Umbrian city of Assisi. With time, his example of personal pastoral conversion began to attract followers from different walks of life. Because of the appearance of numerous heretical movements in medieval society, it was important to ask for the approval and blessing for this radical return to the basics of the Gospel. This could be realized only by a pilgrimage to the Eternal City, to the Pope of Rome for official status for this new form of religious life in the Church.

While waiting to be received in audience at the Papal Court, which at that time was located at the Lateran Basilica, Francis and his brothers preached conversion, penance, and the Gospel on the streets and squares of Rome. It was perchance Lady Jacqueline was attracted by the message and preaching of this beggar and his followers from Umbria. In time, Blessed Lady Giacomina befriended Francis and his early followers and even offered them food and shelter whenever they found themselves in Rome.

Lady Jacqueline was known for her hospitality and kindness, especially to the less fortunate. A noblewoman, a widow, the mother of two young children, and a wealthy benefactor, she also was known for her exceptional weaving of woolen cloth and of course her great baking skills.

Their friendship grew, fortified by their mutual love for Christ and His Bride—the Church. Loved by the early friars, Lady Jacqueline was adopted into the company of the “Lesser Brothers” and affectionally was honored by being addressed as *Fratello Giacomina*—Brother Jacqueline. During her many visits to Assisi, she was the only woman allowed to enter the enclosed area where the first brothers resided.

At Jacoba’s table in Rome. Francis requested that

as a true and dear friend she remember him when the time approaches for his passing from this earthly life to eternal life. Due to the strict poverty that Francesco and his followers embraced, they were not able to even procure the necessities for the proper funeral rites of the day.

Because Lady Jacqueline was a close, trusted, and loyal friend, Saint Francis requested that when the hour approached for his *transitus*, she bring beeswax candles, incense, a woven burial shroud, and her delicious almond cookies so that, before he was embraced by “Sister Death,” he could enjoy her much-loved almond paste treats.

The chronicles relate that on the evening of October, 3, Francesco lay on the ground next to the Little Church of Our Lady of the Angels. It was one of the many chapels restored by his own work-worn hands.

Summoning one of the brothers, Francis spoke of the urgency to quickly run to Rome and tell Brother Jacqueline that her dear friend, her soulmate, her teacher waits in anticipation for their last visit. The friar quickly departed for Rome; fully knowing that on foot it was a journey of several days.

At that same moment, as twilight approached, so too Lady Giacomina of the House of Settesoli arrived with horse, carriage, knights, and servants. Brother Jacqueline ran to be at the side of her beloved, long-time friend. There she gifted him with beeswax candles, incense, a warm burial shroud, a red embroidered pillow to rest his head, and her renowned almond cookies. Brother Jacqueline instinctively knew that it was now the time to assume her place close to her Spiritual Mentor of old.

Today she is known as Blessed Jacoba of the House of Settesoli (seven suns). Her earthly remains are secured in a small casket located in the massive stone wall exactly opposite the tomb of Saint Francis in the lower level in the Basilica of Assisi.
