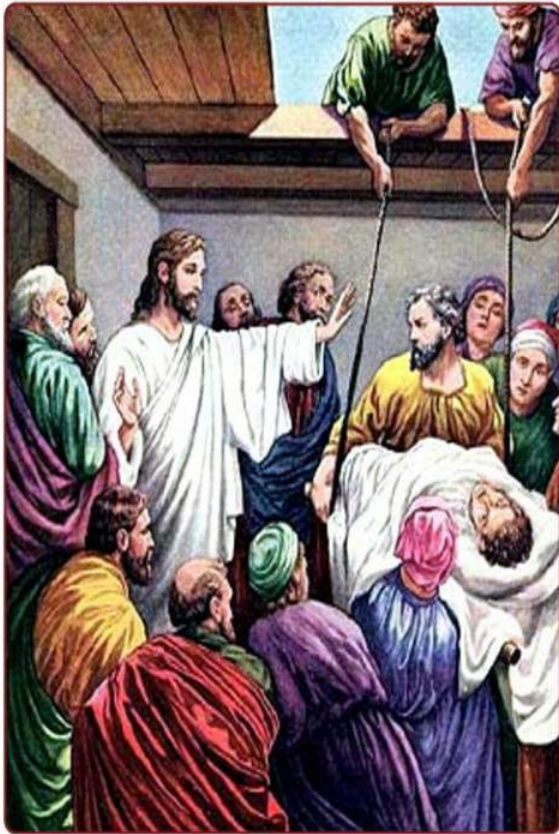

St. Cassian will host a SPECIAL HEALING MISSION, conducted by Paul Rymniak, on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, October 21st, 22nd and 23rd, 2024. All three evenings will begin at 7:00 p.m.

The thrust of all of these evenings will be FORGIVENESS and HEALING. There will be PRIESTS



available for CONFESSION also. Healing starts in the Confessional with the Sacrament of Reconciliation; you might want to consider this option during this time.

Healing is NOT just for the Physically Impaired. Mental and Emotional stresses and strains can take a heavier toll on our lives, even more than the worst of diseases. So if you or your family are in need of HEALING in these areas, come and experience the Lord, and what He can do for you.

Come and enjoy Jesus by Worshiping Him. Come and see what Our Lord has for you. Come and be healed.

Paul Rymniak sees it as an honor to be at our parish to conduct his HEALING MISSION, which also includes the ROSARY and the STATIONS OF THE CROSS. Paul will offer his healing efforts to all who seek it. All Christians are welcome to attend, whether they are Catholic or not.

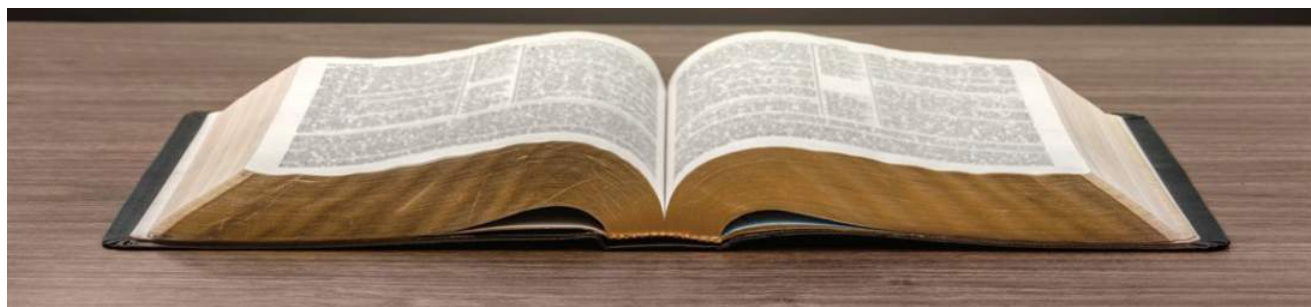
According to Paul, who credits GOD and NOT HIMSELF for his successes, he possesses several hundred testimonies from doctors and lay people that confirm

healings GOD has used him to perform.

He makes NO claim that all who come to him are cured and he theorizes that ANGER within the ill person may prevent healing. GOD'S healing touch is available to everyone. Sometimes it takes the form of physical cures, and sometimes it takes the form of suffering and even DEATH. Whatever GOD chooses it is for the greater good of all.

Paul only claims to be an "ORDINARY" man, many may disagree with his self-assessment, as he is known as a healer throughout the United States, Canada, Puerto Rico and Mexico. He sees Christ working through him and says there is scriptural basis for his work, Matthew 18:19: "when two people come before My Father, asking My Father for anything, My Father will give it to them." This is the basis for his ministry.

Fr. Luke Edelen, OSB, is a monk and priest of the Benedictine Abbey of Newark, a community founded in 1857 at the request of the first Bishop of the Diocese of Newark, James Roosevelt Bagley. The community, which has a parish at the monastery St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception, is best known for its school (established in 1868) St. Benedict's Preparatory, which enrolls students from PreK through Grade 12. The elementary and middle divisions are co-ed; there are separate divisions for boys and girls in the upper division (grades 9–12).

Fr. Luke is a native son of the Archdiocese, having grown up in Union and South Orange. He is an alumnus of St. Benedict's, studied classical languages at Fordham University, and holds an M.A. and M.Div. from St. Vincent Seminary, Latrobe, PA.

He made his first monastic profession in 1973 and was ordained to the priesthood in 1980 in the Abbey Church by Bishop Joseph A. Francis, S.V.D.

Fr. Luke is a Latin teacher at St. Benedict's and served for twelve years as pastor of St. Mary's Parish. His pastoral involvement has continued as a weekend assistant at various parishes in the Archdiocese. He is currently chair of the Archdiocesan Ecumenical Commission.

In the monastic community he has been Master of Ceremonies, member of the Liturgy Committee, Cantor, and frequent delegate to the General Chapter of the American-Cassinense Congregation of the Order of St. Benedict, to which his Abbey belongs.
