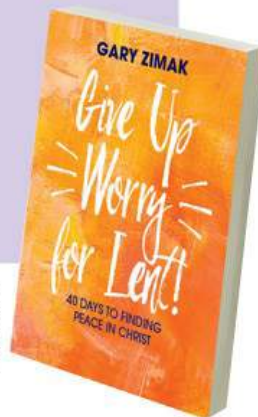

## A Letter from the Principal's Desk



Dear Friends of St. Cassian School,

As we approach the end of the Foundation's Annual Appeal on February 28th, I look back with gratitude for your support throughout the last few years. How wonderful it has been to witness our school and parish community continue to come together time and time again to support our Home and School Association and the St. Cassian School Foundation fundraising efforts! Please know that your contributions of time and/or treasure, no matter how small, make a difference in the overall experience our students have at our school. For this reason, I invite you to prayerfully consider supporting the St. Cassian Foundation Annual Appeal. Your tax deductible donation will be used to continue to enhance and support the unparalleled Catholic education our SCS students receive.

**Below are a few reasons why it is important for all of us to consider making a contribution to the SCS Foundation:**

- **Keeping Tuition at our Parish School Affordable:** The cost of educating each SCS student is \$1700 more than the annual tuition. The Foundation grants help to close the gap. In addition, grants provide the school funding for needs-based scholarships.
- **Maintaining High-Level Academic Programs and Curriculum Resources:** The Foundation grants continue to fund the online annual subscriptions for student access to curriculum materials, the promethium boards used in all of our classrooms, chrome books and laptops for student and teacher use, and much more. A recent grant allowed us to offer a planetarium experience to our students as an in-school field trip.
- **Helping to fund the faith formation program of our students with the purchase of religion curriculum resources.**
- **Enhancing the Arts and Sports Programs:** Grants continue to provide funding for Artist-In-Residence visits, the Spring Musical (Mary Poppins, Jr. ), MIAD elective program supplies, photography and video-making supplies ( ie. green screen, professional mirrorless camera), sports camps, equipment for our sports program ( ie. Volleyball Net System, new professional grade volleyballs and basketballs for all of our teams, new gymnasium basketball system), and playground supplies.
- **Social Emotional Learning:** A recent grant supports funding for the services of a counselor, who provides workshops through whole class instruction on various topics, as well as offers services to individual and small groups of students as needed. Topics addressed include self-awareness, emotional regulation, positive coping strategies, making good choices, thinking before speaking, bullying/roasting, apologizing, forgiveness, and friendship.
- **Promoting School Safety:** Grants awarded by the Foundation help enhance security and safety features, such as, securing entrance doors to our classrooms and school, security cameras, and air filtration devices to promote a healthy environment.

Next time you feel unhappy about something, try to find the hidden blessing!



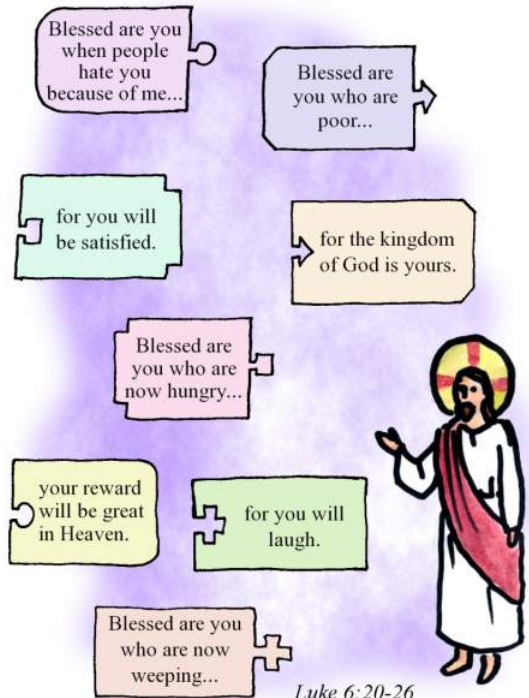
